Aim and Objectives:

- Increased accuracy in planning and forecasting
- Common picture of logistic support framework
- Improved interactions between Force / Mission structures
- Logistic staff better able to articulate impact on the mandate of a logistic decision
- An established standard for pre-deployment certification (individual) and for performance evaluation(individual and organization)
- Staff involved in logistic functions are more functional from first day of deployment
- Better integration with civilian support framework, resulting in more effective utilization of scarce resources towards mandate achievement

Target Audience:

The primary audience is >100 positions rotated annually, with a larger training audience and includes: Uniformed staff officers at Force HQ, Sector HQ, Mission HQ (such as integrated into MSC or other planning cells), U4, U5 in particular and CIMIC cells; Battalion operations/administrative staff –most likely S3, S5, S1, S4 and 2IC Positions; Key uniformed leadership positions; Police logistic liaison officers
